## AVSA 2018 Article Contest



The African Violet Society of America’s (AVSA) 2016/2017 Magazine Article Contest was so successful that it will be extended for another year. Write an original article and submit it to the *African Violet Magazine*. Write about anything relating to our hobby: African violets, Gesneriads, Designing, etc. Winners of the 2017/2018 Article Contest will be announced at the AVSA 2018 Convention in Buffalo, NY.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Winner will receive a total of eight “New Introduction” leaves from the Commercial Members and Hybridizers taking part. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Winner will receive a total of sixteen “New Introduction” leaves from the Commercial Members and Hybridizers taking part. The 1<sup>st</sup> Place Winner will receive a total of thirty-two “New Introduction” leaves from the Commercial Members and Hybridizers!

Rules: Author must be a current member of AVSA. All entered articles must be original work and cannot have been published before. You may write as many articles as you wish and each entry must be marked CONTEST. Submissions must be received AFTER March 1, 2017 but before April 1, 2018. Articles received after this date will NOT be considered. Hybridizers, Commercial Members, and Judges taking part, are not eligible for prizes. The decisions of the Judges will be final. Due to the high cost of shipping leaves internationally, leaves will only be shipped to winners in the US. International members will be required to pick theirs up at the 2018 Buffalo, NY Convention.

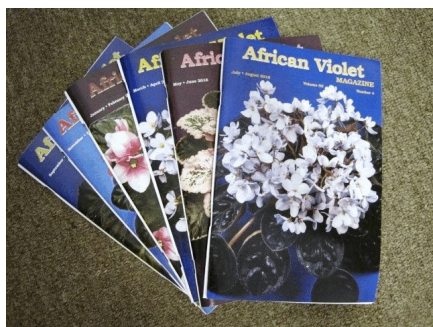
